FEE POLICY

Non-collective-bargaining Mediation and Arbitration: \$250 per hour for study, mediation sessions, arbitration hearings, award preparation, and travel time.

Collective Bargaining Grievance Arbitration, Interest Arbitration, Fact-Finding, and Mediation: 8-hour per diem fee of \$1,200. A day is any portion of a hearing or mediation day up to 8 hours. Prorated per diem is charged for the following activity: hearing or mediation time on hearing or mediation days exceeding 8 hours; prehearing activity; arbitration award preparation; mediation preparation; travel time.

Expenses: Parties will be charged the actual cost of reasonable travel expenses, including air and train fares, car rental, mileage (IRS rate) for use of personal vehicle, and lodging.

Cancellation Policy: A cancellation fee of \$1,200 is charged for each hearing or mediation date cancelled or postponed less than 14 calendar days prior to the scheduled date.
